Itinerary – Myanmar / Burma 3 days Kalaw to Innsein Horse Back Riding



Day 1	Mandalay or Yangon	Heho - Kalaw
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This morning you will be transferred to Mandalay/Yangon airport in order to connect with your onward flight to Heho. Upon arrival, you will be picked up by your local guide and transferred to Kalaw to check in to your hotel.

Originally founded as a hill station by the British wanting to escape the heat of the plains, Kalaw still retains an air of colonial charm and the surrounding countryside offers some of the best trekking in the country. An interesting observation is the noteworthy population of Nepalese and Indians, who arrived here during the time of the British to work on the construction of the railway and the roads.

The rest of the day will be spent exploring this delightful town. Places of interest include Aug Chan Tha Zedi, a glittering stupa in the centre of town and the interesting central market, where it is sometimes possible to see traders from nearby hill-tribe villages selling and buying their wares.

Following breakfast at your hotel transfer to the appointed meeting point. Upon arrival take a short time to warm up your horse and then start your 48-km horseback riding tour which leads you first to Myinmahti Cave situated at the foot of Mount Myinmahti which is a religious site of the native Pa-O people. On arrival at the cave take a short visit of it. Proceed to Zaygone village for lunch, stopping en route at places where you can take refreshments for horses and riders and enjoy our lunch there. Being a mountainous area, the riding trail goes up and down. Riding in the Shan mountain ranges with a vast panoramic view will provide you with an unforgettable experience. You travel by horse to small ethnic villages, learning new customs, seeing the timeless sights and meeting the welcoming and kind Myanmar people. In the evening arrive at the Htitañ village. Enjoy your authentic dinner and overnight at the village.
